THE FISHERIES AND MARINE RESOURCES ACT Regulations made by the Minister under section 74(1)(k) of the Fisheries and Marine Resources Act

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the l'isheries and Marine Resources (Licence and Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 2017.
- In these regulations –
 "principal regulations" means the Fisheries and Marine Resources (Licence and Fees) Regulations 2013.
- 3. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is amended by adding the following new definition, the full stop at the end of the definition of "purse sciner" being deleted and replaced by a semicolon –

"supply vessel" means a vessel which is involved in -

- (a) carrying, deploying, retrieving, searching for, or monitoring a fishing aggregating device;
- (b) assisting a fishing vessel with resupplying, changing or transfering crew; or
- (c) any other supporting service.
- 4. The First Schedule to the principal regulations is amended by adding the following new items and their corresponding entries—
 - 8. Mauritian supply vessel USD 4,000 per annum

 USD 1,000 for every additional period of 90 days
 - 9. Foreign supply vessel USD 5,000 per annum
 USD 1,250 for every additional period of 90 days
